Competition & Rules

Plane

The jump plane used during the competition will be a Cessna 208 Caravan, with a left-hand door. Jump-run will be crosswind. All teams will exit unlinked, turn 90 degrees after exit and make the first linkup in freefall.

Agenda

Thursday/Friday

Thursday and Friday are set for practice days. The caravan will be available to take up loads from Thursday morning.

Should the weather forecast not be very good for the weekend, we may decide to already start the competition Friday morning.

Friday evening

We will have a lottery to decide which figures will be in each round.

For more details on the rounds, check the competition rules PDF (linked above) and website information.

There will be a competition briefing on both Friday night and Saturday morning, regarding the competition rules, rounds, and scoring, in addition to dropzone rules & regulations, landing areas, etc.

Saturday

Short repeat briefing of the previous evening in case anyone wasn't present then.
Each team is allowed one warm-up jump, then we start the competition.
All teams start at the same time.

Important:

All teams wanting to compete have to be on the DZ
and registered **before** 10:00 AM Saturday.

Saturday/Sunday/Monday/Tuesday

Competition jumps, awards ceremony (if all goes to plan, on Sunday evening) and afterward (Monday/Tuesday), formation flying with all the great pilots on the dropzone.
Alejandro, Costyn and Jarno will also be doing load organizing after the competition.
Non-competitors are also more than welcome to join in on these jumps.

Registration and other financial stuff

Registration fee is 25 euro per person. This will cover stuff like prizes and other organizational costs. For non-competitors, the load organizing is 10 euro per day.

Please make sure you have a valid reserve repack (valid in your country), license and insurance before you come to Italy! These things *will* be checked by the dropzone operators when registering.

Jump tickets are 25 euro.

Credit card and most likely Maestro-/debit-cards are accepted for payment. ATMs are located in Terni city itself, not too far from the DZ.
